the destruction he had threatened. But Jonah was greatly displeased and became angry. He prayed to the Lord, "O Lord, is this not what I said when I was still at home? That is why I was so quick to flee to Tarshish. I knew that you are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abounding in love, a God who relents from sending calamity.

This is the word of the Lord. Thanks be to God.



Jonah obeyed the word of the Lord and went to Nineveh. // When the news reached the king of Nineveh, he rose from his throne, took off his royal robes, covered himself with sackcloth and sat down in the dust. God may vet relent and with compassion turn from his fierce anger so that we will not perish."
